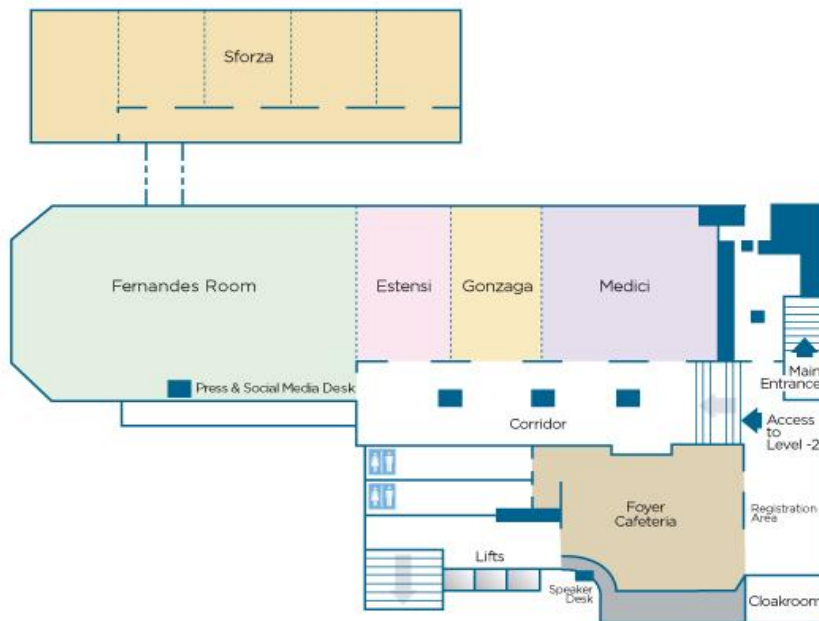


CONFERENCE ON eHEALTH
